*Whitehall, August 6, 1807.*

THE King has been pleased to grant unto the Honourable Fulk Greville Upton, a Lieutenant-Colonel in the Army, (second Son of the Right Honourable Clotworthy, late Lord Templetown in Ireland, deceased,) and to Mary Upton, his Wife, only Child of Richard Howard, of Castle Rising, in the County of Norfolk, Esq; by the Honourable Frances Howard, his Wife, Sister of Henry, and Aunt and Heir of Henry, successively Earls of Suffolk and Berkshire, deceased, His Royal Licence and Authority, that they may, out of Respect towards the said noble Family, and with the Consent and Approbation of the said Richard and Frances Howard, take and use the Surname of Howard only, that the said Fulk Greville Upton may bear the Arms of Howard with a due Distinction; and that the Surname and Arms of Howard may be used and borne by the Issue of their Marriage; such Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Herald's Office:

And also to order that this His Majesty's Concession and Declaration be registered in His College of Arms.
