That the Deliveries are to commence on and for the 25th Day of October next; that Proposals in Writing, sealed up and marked, Tender for Army Supplies, will be received at this Office, on or before the 28th Day of September, (but none will be received after Eleven o'Clock on that Day,) and, if sent by Post, the Postage must be paid.

Proposals must be made separately for each County and Island, and each Proposal must be accompanied by a Letter from Two respectable Persons engaging to become bound with the Person tendering, in the Sum of 1000l. for the due Performance of the Contract; and no Proposal will be noticed, unless made on, or annexed to, a printed Tender, and the Prices expressed in Words at Length; nor unless the Party, or an Agent for him, personally attend on the following Day, to know the Decision thereon; and should it so happen that during the Continuance of the Contract, no Troops should be stationed or supplied in the County, the Expenses of the Contract and Bond paid in the first Instance by the Contractor, to be refunded to him by the Commissary-General.
