

tral Powers resident at this Court, that the rigorous Blockade of the Rivers Elbe, Wezer, and Ems is, for the present, discontinued; and that Neutral Vessels, laden with innocent Goods, the Property of Neutrals, will be suffered to trade at the said Rivers, and the intermediate Rivers, Ports, and Places, provided such Vessels are going from or to a Neutral or British Port, and shall not be trading, nor shall previously have traded, between either of the said Rivers, or the intermediate Rivers, Ports, or Places, and any Port or Place in the Possession, or so far under the Controul of the Enemy, as that British Vessels may not freely trade thereat, nor from one to another of the said Rivers, or intermediate Rivers, Ports, or Places.
