And whereas it is fully justifiable to adopt the fame Rule, in this Refpect, towards the Enemy, which is applied by the Enemy to this Country :

His Majefty is pleafed, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, That in future the Sale to a Neutral of any Veffel belonging to His Majefty's Enemies, shall not be deemed to be legal, nor in any Manner to transfer the Property, nor to alter the Character of fuch Veffel: And all Veffels now belonging, or which shall hereafter belong to any Enemy of His Majefty, notwithstanding any Sale, or pretended Sale to a Neutral, after a reafonable Time shall have elapfed for receiving Information of this His Majefty's Order at the Place where fuch Sale, or pretended Sale, was effected, shall be captured and brought in. and shall be adjudged as lawful Prize to the Captors.
