BY a Claufe in an Act of Parliament, Anno 48' Georgii Tertii Regis, intituled "An Act for " regulating the iffuing and paying off of Exche-" quer Bills," it is enacted, " that from and after " the paffing of this Act, all Exchequer Bills " which shall hereafter be made forth, under the " Authority of any A& of Parliament, shall be " prepared and made out at the Receipt of the " Exchequer, in such Method and Form as the "Commiffioners of His Majelty's Treasury shall " think most fafe and convenient, and may contain " one common Sum, or different Sums, in the Prin-" cipal Monies: Provided always, that every fuch " Exchequer Bill shall and may be figned by the Auditor of the Receipt of His Majesty's Ex-11 chequer, or in his Name by any Perfon duly " " authorized by the faid Auditor to fign the fame, " with the Approbation of the Lords Commif-" fioners of the Treasury, in Writing under their "Hands, and that every fuch Authority shall be duly registered in the proper Office for the Issue " of Exchequer Bills, and Notice thereof published " in the London Gazette before any Exchequer "Bill, figned by virtue of fuch Authority, shall " be put into Circulation :"

These are to certify your Lordships, that I have appointed and chosen JAMES FISHER, Esq; Chief Clerk in my Office as Auditor of the Receipt of His Majesty's Exchequer, to sign in my Name all Exchequer Bills that shall or may be issued under the Authority of the above-recited Act, or any other Act or Acts of Parliament, and do present him for your Lordships' Approbation.
