

Pursuant to a Decree of His Majesty's Court of Exchequer at Westminster, in a Cause Lownds against Lownds, the Creditors and Legatees of William Lownds, late of Upper Clapton, in the Parish of Saint John, Hackney, in the County of Middlesex, Esq; deceased, are forthwith to come in by their Solicitors and prove their respective Debts, and claim their respective Legacies, before Abel Moysey, Esq; Deputy-Remembrancer of the said Court, at his Chambers in the Exchequer-Office, in the Inner-Temple, London, or in Default thereof they will be excluded the Benefit of the said Decree.
