## PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

HIS Majelty, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, is pleafed to order, and it is hereby ordered, that all Portuguefe Property now detained, and not already decreed to be reflored, nor entitled to Reflitution under His Majefty's Order of the Sixth of January last, shall be forthwith de-creed to be reftored upon Claims given or to be given for the fame, either by the Portuguese Con-ful, or other Person duly authorized by the Portuguele Minister resident at this Court, or by the Agents (duly authorized) of those Owners and Proprietors who are not refident in Portugal, or in other Places subject to the Influence and Controul of France, and that the Part of the Property fo reftored belonging to Perfons not refiding in Por-tugal, or in other Places fubject to the Influence and Controul of France, shall be for the Use and Benefit of the Owners and Proprietors thereof; and the Part belonging jointly to Perfons refident in Portugal, and Perfons relident in the Brazils, or in any Settlement belonging to the Crown of Portu-gal, or in the United Kingdom, or in any Country in Amity with His Majelty, shall be given up to fuch of the Owners and Proprietors thereof as are refident as last mentioned, upon an Engagement entered into and Security given by or on the Behalf of the faid Part Owners and Proprietors, to the Satisfaction of the Portuguele Minister, to account to the Prince Regent of Portugal for fuch Part of the faid joint Property as shall belong to Perfons refident in Portugal, or in other Places subject to the Influence and Controul of France ; and the Part belonging to Persons relident in Portugal, or in other Places subject to the Influence and Con-troul of France, shall be at the future Disposition of the Prince Regent of Portugal.

And it is further ordered, that the joint Agents to whom the Property has been or shall be delivered purfuant to the faid Order of the Sixth of January last, shall be, and they are hereby authorized and directed, after the faid Property shall have been jetty's Poilession, shall be permitted to be imported decreed to be reftored, to proceed to the Sale of Linto any of the Ports of the United Kingdom of

T the Court at the Queen's Palace, the 4th of | fuch Property. or of fuch Parts thereof, as the Portuguele Minister resident at this Court shall signify to them, in Writing, the Expediency of felling in the Manner most beneficial for the Parties interested therein, and to invest the Proceeds of such Part as shall be fold in Government Securities, under the previous Sanction, in Writing, of the Portuguele Minister, and to hold the fame, together with the Property not fold, at the Difpofal and fubject to the future Directions of the Prince Regent of Portugal, to be fignified to them through his Mi-nister resident in London: And the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty. and the Judge of the High Court of Admiralty, and Judges of the Courts of Vice-Admiralty, are to take the neceffary Measures herein as to them shall respectively appertain. ## PRESENT,

The KING's Moft Excellent Majefty in Council.

XTHEREAS the Islands of Saint Thomas, Saint John, and Sainte Croix, and their Dependencies, have been furrendered and placed under the immediate Protection of His Majesty's Arms, and the Territories and Forts of the fame have been delivered up to His Majesty, and the faid Islands are now in His Majesty's Possession ; His Majefty is thereupon pleafed to order and declare, and it is hereby ordered and declared, that all His loving Subjects may lawfully trade to and from the faid Islands, subject nevertheless to the same Duties, Rules, Regulations, Conditions, Restrictions, Penalties, and Forfeitures, to which the Trade to and from His Majefty's Colonies, Plantations, and Islands in the West Indies is or shall be subject by Law .: And His Majeky is further pleafed to order and declare, and it is hereby ordered and declared, that all Commodities, being the Growth, Produce, or Manufacture of the faid Islands of Saint Thomas, Saint John, and Sainte Croix, being in His Ma-
