the Wind, which enabled me to get within Musketshot; and, after an Action of Twenty Minutes, she blew up and sunk. The State of the Weather, being nearly calm under the Land, the Fire of the Batteries and feveral Boats coming from the Shore, I was under the Necessity of quitting the Wreck without faving the Life of a single one of her Crew. The Danish Cutter appeared to be a Vessel of about One Hundred and Twenty Tons, and mounting Eight or Ten Guns, and apparently full of Men. I am happy to add not a Man under my Command, or the Vessel, received the least Damage.
