PROCLAMATION, Α

Revoking the former Proclamations relating to the Diffribution of Prizes, and appointing a new Distribution thereof.

GEORGE R. WHEREAS it has been reprefented to Us by Our Committeners for committeners to Com VV Our Commiffioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral, that it will be productive of beneficial Effects to the Service, if, instead of the Three Eighth Parts of the neat Produce of Prizes, which have hitherto been granted to the Captains and Flag-Officers ferving in Our Fleet, Two Eighth Parts only shall be allotted to them, and the remaining Eighth Part distributed amongst the Petty Officers, Seamen, and Marines, in addition to their prefent Shares; We do therefore, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Council, think fit to iffue this Our Royal Proclamation, hereby revoking our feveral Proclamations heretofore iffued, and now in Force, concerning the Distribution of Prizes taken by Our Fleets and Ships, and by all other Ships and Veffels that are or shall be commissionated by Letters of Marque or General Reprizals, against the Ships, Goods, and Subjects of any of the Countries with which We are at War: Provided always, that the Distribution hereinafter made shall not be construed to affect any Prizes which have been captured before the Day of the Date of this Our Royal Proclama-tion, nor any Prizes which shall be captured after that Day, and which shall be condemned in any of Our Courts of Vice-Admiralty, before Notice of this Our Royal Proclamation shall have been received by the Court of Vice-Admiralty in which fuch Condemnation shall pass; and We do hereby declare, that the Produce of all fuch Prizes as shall have been captured before the Day of the Date of this Our Royal Proclamation, or shall be captured that Day, and shall be condemned in any of Our Courts of Vice-Admiralty antecedent to the Notice of this Our Royal Proclamation having been received in fuch Court, shall continue to be distributed in the Proportions directed by Our faid former Proclamations; and We do now make known to all Cur loving Subjects, and all others whom it may concern by this Our Royal Proclamation, by and with the Confent of Qur Privy Council, that

Our Will and Fleafure is, that the Neat Produce of all Prizes taken, the Right whereof is inherent in Us and Our Crown, be given to the Taker, (fave and except the Produce of fuch Prizes as are or fhall be taken by Ships or Veffels belonging to, or hired by, or in the Service of Our Commiffioners of Cuftoms or Excife, the Disposition of which We referve to Our further Pleafure, and alfo fave and except as hereinafter-mentioned;) but fubject to the Payment of all fuch or the like Customs and Duties as the fame are now or would have been liable to if the fame were or might have been imported as Merchandize; and that the fame may be to given in the Pro-portion and Manner hereinafter fet forth, that is to

fay, That all Prizes taken by Ships and Veffels having Commiffions of Letters of Marque and Reprizals, (fave and except fuch Prizes as are or shall be taken by the Ships or Veffels belonging to, or hired by, or in the Service of Our Commissioners aforefaid,) may be fold and disposed of by the Merchants, Owners, Fitters, and others, to whom fuch Letters of Marque and Reprizals are granted, for their own Use and Benefit after final Adjudication, and not before.

And we do hereby further order and direct, that the neat Produce of all Prizes which are or shall be taken by any of Our Ships or Vellels of War (fave and except when they shall be acting on any conjunct Expedition with Our Army, in which Cafe We referve to Ourfelves the Division and Distribution of all Prize and Booty taken; and also fave and except as herein-after mentioned) shall be for the entire Benefit and Encouragement of Our Flag Officers, Captains, Commanders, and other Commissioned Officers in Our Pay, and of the Seamen, Marines, and Soldiers on board Our faid Ships and Veffeis at the Time of the Capture; and that fuch Prizes may be lawfully fold and disposed of by them and their Agents after the fame shall have been to Us finally adjudged lawful Prize, and not otherwife.

The Distribution shall be made as follows:-The Whole of the Net Produce being being first divided into Eight equal Parts.

The Captain or Captains of any of Our faid Ships or Veffels of War, or Officer commanding fuch Ship or Veffel, who shall be actually on board at the taking of any Prize, shall have Two-Eighth Parts, but in cafe any fuch Prize shall be taken by
