## PROCLAMATION,

Revoking the former Proclamations relating to the Diffribution of Prizes, and appointing a new Distribution thereof.

GEORGE R.

WHEREAS it has been reprefented to Us by Our Commissioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral, that it will be productive of beneficial Effects to the Service, if, inflead of the Eighth Parts of the neat Produce of Prizes, and Flag Officers ferving in Our Fleet, Two Eighth Parts only thall be allotted to them, and the remaining Eighth Part diffributed amongst the Petty Officers, Seamen, and Marines, in addition to their prefent Shares; We do therefore, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Council, think fit to iffue this Our Royal Proclamation, hereby revoking our fe-veral Proclamations heretofore iffued, and now in Force, concerning the Distribution of Prizes taken by Our Fleets and Ships, and by all other Ships and Vefiels that are or fhall be commilionated by Letters

of Marque or General Reprizals, against the Ships, Goods, and Subjects of any of the Countries with which We are at War : Provided always, that the Distribution hereinafter made shall not be construed to affest any Prizes which have been captured before the Day of the Date of this Our Royal Proclamation, nor any Prizes which shall be captured after that Day, and which shall be condemned in any of Our Courts of Vice-Admiralty, before Notice of this Our Royal Proclamation shall have been received by the Court of Vice-Admiralty in which fuch Condemnation shall pass; and We do hereby declare, that the Produce of all such Prizes as shall have been captured before the Day of the Date of this Our Royal Proclumation, or fhall be captured that Day, and faill be condemned in any of Our Courts of Vice-Admiralty antecedent to the Netice of this Our Royal Preclamation having been received in fuch Court, shall continue to be distributed in the Proportions directed by Our faid former Proclamations; and We do now make known to all Our loving Subjects, and all others whom it may concern by this Our Royal Proclamation, by and with the Confent of Our Privy Council, that

Our Will and Pleafure is, that the Neat Produce of all Prizes taken, the Right whereof is inherent in Us and Our Crown, be given to the Taker, fave and except the Produce of fuch Prizes as are or fhall be taken by Ships or Veffels belonging to, or hired by, or in the Service of Our Commiffiners of Cuftoms or Excife, the Disposition of which We referve to Our further Pleafure, and alfo fave and except as hereinafter-mentioned;) but fubject to the Payment of all fuch or the like Cuftoms and Duties as the fame are now or would have been liable to if the fame were or might have been imported as Merchandize; and that the fame may be fo given in the Proportion and Manner hereinafter fet forth, that is to

fay, That all Prizes taken by Ships and Veffels having Margue and Reprizals, (fave and except fuch Prizes as are or shall be takin by the Ships or Vessels belonging to, or hired by, or in the Service of Our Commiffioners aforefaid, ) may be feld and disposed of by the Merchants, Owners, Fitters, and others, to whom fuch Letters of Marque and Reprizals are granted, for their own Use and Benefit after final Adjudication, and not before.

And we do hereby further order and direct, that the next Produce of all Prizes which are or shall be taken by any of Our Ships or Veffels of War (fave and except when they find he acting on any conjunct Expedition with Our Army, in which Cafe We referve to Outfelves the Division and Diffribution of all Prize and Booty taken; and alfo fave and except as hereia-after mentioned) shall be for the entire Bene-fit and Encouragement of Our Flag Officer;, Captaine, Commanders, and other Commissioned Officers in Cur Pay, and of the Scamen, Marines, and Seldiers on board Our faid Ship: and Veffels at the Time of the Capture; and that fuch Prizes may be lawfully fold and difpoled of by them and their Aments after the fame shall have been to Us finally ... ad edged lawful Prize, and not otherwife. The Diftribution faall be made as follows:-The

Whole of the Net Produce being first divided into Eight equal Parts,

The Captain or Captains of any of Our faid Ships or Veffels of War, or Officer commanding fuch Ship or Veffel, who shall be actually on board at the taking of any Prize, shall have Two-Eighth Parts, but in cafe any fuch Prize shall be taken by
