Whitehall, December 3, 1808. HE King has been pleased to order a Congé d'Elire to pass the Great Seal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, empowering the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of Rochester to elect a Bishop of that See, the same being void by the Translation of the Right Reverend l'ather in God Thomas, late Bishop thereof, to the See of Ely; and His Majesty has also been pleafed, by His Royal Sign Manual, to recommend to the said Dean and Chapter the Reverend Walker King, Doctor in Divinity, to be by them elected Bishop of the said See of Rochester.

The King has been pleased to present the Reverend David Watson to the Church and Parish of Leuchars, in the Presbytery of St. Andrew's, and County of Fife, the same being void by the Death of Mr. Thomas Kettle, late Minister there.
