APROCLAMATION,
For a General Fast.

GEORGE R.

17 E, taking into Our most ferious Consideration the just and necessary War in which We are engaged, and putting Our Trust in Almighty God that He will graciously bles Our Arms both by Sea and Land, have resolved, and do, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Council, hereby command, that a Publick Day of Fasting and Humiliation be observed throughout those Parts of Our United Kingdom called England and Ireland, on Wednesday the Eighth Day of February next and Wednesday the Eighth Day of February next enfung; that so both We and Our People may humble Ourfelves before Almighty God, in order to obtain Pardon of Our Sins, and, in the most devout and solemn Manner, send up Our Prayers and Supplications to the Divine Majesty for averting those heavy Judgments which Our manifold Provocations have most justly deserved, and for imploring His Blessing and Assistance on Our Arms for the Restoration of Peace and Prosperity to Us and Our Dominions: And We do strictly charge and command that the faid Publick Fast be reverently and devoutly observed by all Our loving Subjects in England and Ireland, as they tender the Favour of Almighty God, and would avoid his Wrath and Indignation, and upon Pain of fuch Punishment as We may justly inslict on such as contemn and neglect the Performance of fo religious and necessary a Duty: And for the better and more orderly solemnizing the fame, We have given Directions to the Most Reverend the Archbishops, and the Right Reverend the Bishops of England and Ireland, to compose a Form of Prayer suitable to this Occa-Son to be used in all Churches, Chapels, and Places of Publick Worning; and to take care that the some be timely dispersed throughout their respective Dioceles.

[1] E, taking into Our most serious Consideration VV the just and necessary War in which We are engaged, and putting Our Trust in Almighty God that He will graciously bless Our Arms both by Sea and Land, have refolved, and do, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Council, hereby command, that a Publick Day of Fasting and Humiliation be observed throughout that Part of Our Kingdom of Creek British and Charles Our Cha Kingdom of Great Britain called Scotland, on Thursday the Ninth Day of February next enfuing; that so both We and Cur People may humble Ourselves before Almighty God, in order to obtain Pardon of Our Sins, and, in the most devout and solemn Manner, send up Our Prayers and Supplications to the Divine Majesty for averting those heavy Judgments which Our manifold Provocations have most justly deserved, and for imploring His Blessing and Assistance on our Arms for the Refloration of Peace and Profperity to Us and Our Dominions: And We do strictly charge and command that the faid Publick Fast be reverently and devoutly observed by all Our loving Subjects in Scotland, as they tender the Favour of Almighty. God, and would avoid His Wrath and Indignation, and upon Pain of such Punishment as We may jutly inflict on all such as contemn and neglect the Performance of fo religious and necessary a Duty:
Our Will is, therefore, and We charge that this Our Proclamation feen, ye forthwith proceed to the Market-Crofs of Edinburgh, and all other Places needful, and there, in Our Name and Authority, make Publication thereof, that none pretend Ignorance: And Our Will and Pleasure is, that Our Solicitor do cause printed Copies hereof to be sent to the Sheriffs of the several Shires, Stewarts of Stewartries, and Bailiffs of Regalities, and their Clerks, whom We ordain to fee the fame published: And We do appoint them to fend Copies hereof to the feveral Parish Churches within their Bounds; and that upon the Lord's Day immediately preceding the Day abovementioned, the fame may be pub-
