Gopy of a Letter from Captain Newcombe, of His Majesty's Sloop Beagle, addressed to Commodore Owen, and transmitted by Vice-Admiral Campbell, Commander in Chief of His Majesty's Ships and Vessels in the Downs, to the Honourable W. W. Pole, dated the 18th Inflant.

BEG Leave to acquaint you, that early this Morning, (Boulogne bearing about S. S. E. Six Leagues,) His Majelly's Sloop under my Command captured a French Privatcer, named La Formand Captured A French Privatcer, named Captured A French Privatcer, named tune, of Fourteen Guns and Fifty-eight Men, and commanded by Captain Tucker. She was from Calais, Two Days on her Cruife, and had not made any Capture.

From their usual Intrepidity, they did not furrender until the Beagle ran her alongfide, notwithstanding it blew strong with a heavy Sea. One of

their Crew was mortally wounded.
