PRESENT,

The Lords of His Majefty's Molt Honourable Privy Council,

WHEREAS by Order in Council, bearing Date the Eighteenth of this inftant April, it was, among other Things, directed that all Ships and Veffels coming from or having touched at the Ports of Stockholm and Carlferona, or any other Port of Sweden, should come to Anchor at fuch Place and Places as fhould be appointed by the Commiffioners of His Majelty's Cultoms, in order that the State of Health of the Crew and Perfons on board fuch Ships and Veffels fhould be duly examined into and alcertained prior to fuch Ships and Veffels being permitted to enter their Ports of Deftination ; and that in certain Cafes mentioned in the faid Order, all fuch Ships and Veffels, with their Cargoes and Perfons on board, fhould perform a Quarantine of Fifteen Days: And whereas it has been reprefented to this Board, that the Fever of a contagious Defcription, which had prevailed in the Ports of Stockholm and Carlferona during fome Part of the last Winter, had never manifested itself at Gottenburgh or other Ports of Sweden, except the Ports of Stockholm and Carlferoua, it is hereby ordered in Council, that the Precautions and Regulations contained in the faid Order in Council, bearing Date the Eighteenth of this inftant, be revoked (and they are hereby revoked) fo far as respects all Ships and Vefiels which are arrived, or may arrive in any of the Ports of this Kingdom, or the Iflands of Guernfey, Jerfey, Alderney, Sark, and Man, from any of the Ports of Sweden, except from the Ports of Stockholm and Carlferona.

And the Right Honourable the Lords Commiffioners of His Majefly's Treafury, the Commissioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, the Lord Warden of the Cinque ing any Intercourfe or Communication with them.

T the Council Chamber Whitehall, the 29th of] Forts, the Mafter-General and the reft of the principal Officers of the Ordnance, His Majefty's Secretary at War, and the Governors and Commarders in Chief for the Time being of the faid Ifles of Guernfey, Jerfey, Alderney, Sark, and Man, are to give the neceffary Directions herein as to them may respectively appertain. WHEREAS by an Act, passed in the Forty-fifth Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for making further Provision for the effectual Performance of Quarantine," it is among other Things enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the Lords and others of His Majesty's Privy Council, or any Three or more of them, to make fuch Order as they shall fee necessary and expedient upon any unforeseen Emergency, or in any particular Cafe or Cafes with refpect to any Ship or Ships, Veffel or Veffels arriving and having any infectious Difeate or Diftemper on board, or on board of which any infectious Difeale or Diltemper may have appeared in the Courfe of the Voyage, or arriving under any other alarming or fulpicious Circumstances as to Infection, although fuch Ship or Ships, Vefici or Veffels shall not have come from any Place or Places from which His Majelty, His Heirs or Succeffors, by and with the Advice of His or Their Privy Council, may have adjudged and declared it probable that the Plague, or any fuch infectious Difeafe or Diffemper may be brought, and also with respect to the Persons, Goods, Wares, and Merchandize on board the fame; and all fuch Orders fo made by the Lords or others of the Privy Council, or any Three or more of them as aforefaid, shall be as good, valid, and effectual to all Intents and Purpoles (as well with respect to the Commander, Master, or other Person having the Charge of any fuch Ship or Veffel, and all other Perfons on board the fame, as with refpect to any other Perfons hav-
