Copy of a Letter from the Honourable Captain Jones of His Majefy's Sloop the Talbot, addreffed to Rear-Admiral Sir Commodore Nagle, Commander in Chief at Leith, and transmitted by the latter to the Honourable W. W. Pole.

His Majefly's Sloop Tallet, of the Waze SIR, of Norway, 13th June 1809. HAVE the Honour to inform you, that I have this Day captured the Danish Privateer named in the Margin*, after a fhort Chace, having two long Guns on board, which she diffmounted during the Chace, alfo a Number of Imall Arms and a Complement of Eleven Men. She left Norway this Morning, and has made no Captures.
