Copy of a Letter from the Honourable Captain Jones of His Majesty's Sloop the *Talbot*, addressed to Rear-Admiral Sir Commodore Nagle, Commander in Chief at Leith, and transmitted by the latter to the Honourable W. W. Pole.

His Majesty's Sloop *Talbot*, off the *Naze of Norway*, 13th June 1809.

SIR,
I HAVE the Honour to inform you, that I have this Day captured the Danish Privateer named in the *Margin**, after a short Chace, having two long Guns on board, which she dismounted during the Chace, also a Number of small Arms and a Complement of Eleven Men. She left Norway this Morning, and has made no Captures.
