THE King has been pleafed to order a Congé d'Elire to país the Great Seal, empowering the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of Chefter to elect a Bishop of that See, the same being void by the Translation of the Right Reverend Father in God. Henry William, late Bishop thereof, to the See of Bangor; and His Majesty has also been pleased, by His Royal Sign Manual, to recommend to the faid Dean and Chapter the Reverend Bowyer Edward Sparke, Doctor in Divinity, to be by them elected Bishop of the laid See of Chefter.

The King has also been pleafed to recommend to the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of St. Paul, London, the Honourable and Reverend Gerald Valerian Wellesley, Clerk, Master of Arts, to be by them elected into the Place of Canon Relidentiary of the faid Cathedral Church, the fame being vacant by the Translation of the Right Reverend Father in God, Henry William, late Bishöp of Chefter, to the See of Bangor.

The King has allo been pleafed to grant to the Reverend William Harry Edward Bentinck, Clerk, Master of Arts, the Place and Dignity of a Pre-bendary of the Collegiate Church of Saint Peter Westminster, void by the Refignation of the Ho-nourable and Reverend Gerald Valerian Wellessey.
