THE LORDS COMMISSIONERS OF ΒY HIS MAJESTY'S TREASURY.

WHEREAS by an Act paffed in the Forty-third Year of His prefent Majefty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for permitting certain Goods imported into Great Britain, to be fecured in Warchoufes without Payment of Duty," It is enacted, That it should be lawful for the Importer or Importers, Proprietor or Proprietors, Confignee or Confignees of any of the Goods, Wares or Merchandize, enumerated or defcribed in the Table thereunto annexed, marked (B.), and which shall be legally imported and brought into the Port of London, to lodge and fecure the fame under the joint Locks of the Crown and the London Dock Company, in any Warehoufe or Warehoufes, erected or to be erected, fituate within the Premifes belonging to the Lo don Dock Company, without Payment at the Time of the first Entry of such Goods, Warss and Merchandizes of the Duties of Customs or Excife due on the Importation thereof, subject neverthelefs to the Rules, Regulations, and Reltrictions therein contained : Provided that no fuch Goods, Wares or Merchandize foodld be fooldged or fecured unlefs and until fich Warehoufes or other Works belonging or to belong thereto, should be fo far compleated, that in the Judgement of the Lord High Treaturer or the Committioners of His Majefty's Treatury for the Time being, or any Three or more of them, the fame shall be fit and proper in every respect for the Reception of such Goods, Wares and Merchandize, and wherein the Robert Alexander Crickitt, Elq.
