VICE-ADMIRAL SIR HENRY EDWYN STANHOPE, Bart. Commander in Chief at Sheerness, has transmitted to John Wilson Croker, Esq; a Letter he had received from Captain Ferguson, of His Majesty's Sloop Pandora, giving an Account of his having, on the 31st of last Month, captured the French Privateer Cutter, the Chasseur, of Sixteen Guns, (thrown overboard during the Chase,) and Thirty-six Men; out Two Days from the Island of Fora, without making any Capture.
