### Commercial Dock Company.

**W**HEREAS by an Act of Parliament, made and passed in the Fiftieth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled "An Act for maintaining and improving the Docks and Warehouses called the Commercial Docks, and for making and maintaining other Docks and Warehouses to communicate therewith, all in the Parish of St. Mary, Rotherhithe, in the County of Surrey," (being the Act constituting the Commercial Dock Company,) it is, amongst other Things, enacted, that it shall be lawful for the Company to raise amongst themselves, in addition to the Shares already created, or Sums already subscribed for, a further Sum of Money by new Shares, not exceeding the Sum of Money therein mentioned, and that the same shall be divided into Shares; and it is by the said Act provided, that all or any Person or Persons, Boaries Politic or Corporate, who, at the Time of the creating or making the new Shares thereby authorised to be subscribed for, shall be possessed of any of the Shares then already subscribed for, shall be entitled, if they so please, to subscribe for any Number of the said new Shares, not exceeding the Number of old Shares of which he or they shall then be possessed:
