

minions: And We do strictly charge and command, That the said Publick Fast be reverently and devoutly observed by all His Majesty's loving Subjects in Scotland, as they tender the Favour of Almighty God, and would avoid His Wrath and Indignation, and upon Pain of such Punishment as may be justly inflicted on all such as contemn and neglect the Performance of so religious and necessary a Duty: Our Will is, therefore, and We charge, That this Our Proclamation seen, ye forthwith proceed to the Market Cross of Edinburgh, and all other Places needful, and there, in His Majesty's Name and Authority, make Publication hereof, that none pretend Ignorance: And Our Will and Pleasure is, That His Majesty's Solicitor do cause printed Copies hereof to be sent to the Sheriffs of the several Shires, Stewarts of Stewartries, and Bailiffs of Regalities, and their Clerks, whom We ordain to see the same published; and We do appoint them to send Copies hereof to the several Parish Churches within their Bounds; and that, upon the Lord's Day immediately preceding the Day above-mentioned, the same may be published, and read from the Pulpits immediately after Divine Service.

Given at Our Court at Carlton-House, this Eighth Day of February One thousand eight hundred and eleven, in the Fifty-first Year of His Majesty's Reign.
