

BEG Leave to inform you, for the Information of the Lords Commiffioners of the Admiralty, of my having on the 21st Instant, at Eight A. M. in Latitude 49° 49' North, Longitude 7° 6' Weft, fallen in with the Confiance French Schooner Pri-vateer, of Sixteen Guns, (Fourteen of which fhe threw overboard in the Chale), and Sixty-two Men, and after a Chale of Eight Hours, blowing hard, difcovered Two Sbips a-head, which the Chafe obferving altered her Courfe, and we immediately fucceeded in capturing her. She appears to be a very fine Copper-bottomed Veffel, fails remarkably falt, and is well calculated for His Majefty's Service. I have, &c.
