Westminster, May 14, 1811. THIS. Day, the Lords being met, a Message was lent to the Honourable House of Com-mons by the Yeoman Usher of the Black Rod, acquainting them, that The Lords, autho-rifed by virtue of a Commission under the Great Seal, jugned by the Prince Regent, in the Name and on the Behalf of His Majesty, for declaring His Majesty's Royal Affent to several Ass agreed upon by both House, do desire the immediate Attendance of the Ho-nourable House in the House of Peers to hear the Com-mission read; and the Commons being come thither, wiffion read; and the Commons being come thither, the faid Commiffion, empowering the Lord Arch-bifhop of Canterbury, the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, and feveral other Lords therein named, to declare and notify the Royal Affent to the faid Acts, was read accordingly, and the Royal Allent given to

An Act for railing the Sum of Two Millions Five Hundred Thouland Pounds, by way of Annuities and Treafury Bills, for the Service of Ireland.

An Act for rendering more effectual an Act made in the Forty-feventh Year of His Majefty's Reign, intituled "An Act for the Abolition of the Slave Trade."

An AA to repeal fo much of an AA of the Nineteenth Year of His present Majefty as prevents Masters of Ships removing their Vessels out of the Stream, except to the lawful Quays in the Port of London, before the Goods are difcharged, or their Veffels are cleared by the proper Officers, Inwards or Outwards, fo far as relates to any Ship or Vef-Tel entered Inwards or Outwards from or to any Port in Ireland.

An AA for further continuing, until the Twentyfifth Day of Jury One thousand eight hundred and thirteen, an Act made in the Thirty-third Year of His prefent Majelty, for rendering the Payment of Creditors more equal and expeditious in Scotland.

An Act to amend and render more effectual an Act of His prefent Majefty, for maintaining and improving the Docks and Warehoufes called the Commercial Docks, in the Parifu of Saint Mary, Rotherhithe, in the County of Surrey; and for ex-tending the Powers of the Iaid A.C.

An Act for making a Navigable Canal from the River Avon, at or near Morgan's Pill, in the Pa-rifh of Ealton in Gordano otherwife Saint George's, in the County of Somerfet, to or near the River Tone, in the Parith of Saint James, in Taunton, in the faid County, and a certain Mayigable Cut therein deferibed therein described.

An Act for vefling in the Julices of the Peace for the County of Rutland a new Gaol and Bridg-well for that County, and the Ground purchased
