A T the Court at York-Houfe, the 6th of September 1811,

## PRESENT,

His Royal Highnels the PRINCE REGENT in Council.

HEREAS by an ACT passed in the Forty-fixth Year of His Majefty's Reign, intituled " An Act for making additional and further Pro-" vitions for the effectual Performance of Quarau-" tine," it is among to other Things enacted, that it shall and may be lawful to and for His 'Majesty, his Heirs or Successors, by his or their Order or Orders in Council, notified by Proclamation, or published in the London Gazette, to prohibit all Perfons, Ships, Boats, and Veffels whatfoever, from going, under any Pretence whatfoever, within the Limits of any Station which by His Majefty, his Heirs or Succeffors, by any fuch Order or Orders in Council, has been or may be affigued for the Performance of Quarantine by any Ships or Veffels winhout clean Bills of Health, and that if any Perfois whatfoever, affer fach Notification or Publication of any fuch Order or Orders in Council, shall prelume, under any Pretence whatfoever, to go with any Ship, Boat, or Veffel within the Limits of any fuch Station, he or Greishall, for every fuch Offence, forfeit and pay the Sum of Five Hundred Founds : And whereas by His Majefty's Order in Council, bearing Date the Fifth of April One thoufand eight hundred and five, it is directed that a feparate and diffinct Place shall be appointed and marked out with Yellow Buoys, for the Performance: of Quarantine at the Motherbank by certain Veffels' therein defcribed, having clean Bills of Health, and by all Ships of War, Transports, and other Ships in the actual Service of Government, under the Command of commiffioned Officers of His Majefty's Navy, coming from the Places therein in that Behalf' mentioned, and not being furnished with clean Bills of Health, which Place was appointed and marked out with Yellow Buoys accordingly : And whereas

His Majefty, in purfuance of the Powers vefted in him by the faid Act, was pleafed, by his Order in Council of the Twenty-first of July One thousand eight hundred and fix, to order, and it was thereby ordered, that no Perfons, Ships, Veffels, or Boats whatfoever, other than the Veffels or Boats belonging to the Superintendant of Quatantine or his Affiltant, or other Boats regularly employed under the Authority of the Commissioners of His Majelty's Cultoms in the Quarantine Service, flould go, under any Pretence whatfoever, within the Limits of the Place to marked out, except in Cales of special Necessity and Emergency, and with Permittion first had and obtained from' the Superintendant of Quarantine at the Motherbank, or his Affiftant ; and it was thereby further ordered, that an Ships and Veffels, being furnished with clean Bals of Health, and Boats liable to Quarantine, which might be ordered to perform the fame at the Motherbank, should come. to perform the tame at the Moneroank, moug come to Anchor within the Compais of the faid Buoys, in fuch Place or Places as mould be directed by the Superintendant of Quarantine or his Alfiltant, and fhould be kept fepanate and apart from His Ma-jefty's Ships of War, Transforts, and Veffels in the Service of Government, and not having clean Bills is the state mind the performing Quarantine of Health, which might be performing Quarantine, as aforefaid within the Compass of the faid veloce Buoys: And whereas it hath been represented that the Space to marked out on the Motherbank, within which Ships under Quarantine are to be moored, was more extensive than was necessary for any Number of Ships which it was prohable would have occasion to be there at one Time, and that the Extent of the Space to marked out rendered it extremely difficult, with the Wind at certain Points of the Compais, for Veffels which might, not be subject to Quarantine to avoid passing, through Parts of that Space, and thereby subjecting the Commander of fush Veffels to the Penaltics provided by the before menuoned Ach palled in the Forty-fixth Year of His Majely's:
