### GOLD COIN.

**W**HEREAS great Quantities of the Gold Coin of this Realm have been clandestinely and illegally exported from various Parts of England; and whereas it is highly expedient to prevent such unlawful Practice, and to discover and punish the Offenders.

The Commissioners of His Majesty's Customs in England do hereby give Notice, that in case any Person or Persons will give Information of any of such illicit Practices, so that any Seizures shall be made of any such Gold Coin in consequence thereof, the Person or Persons giving such Information shall, immediately after such Coin shall have been condemned, receive ONE THIRD PART of the Value of such Seizures, without any Deduction whatever.
