VIIIS day, the Lords, being met, a message was sent to the Honourable House of Commons by the Yeoman Usher of the Black Rod, acquainting them, that The Lards, authorised by virtue of a Commission under the Great Seal, signed by the Prince Regent, in the name and on the behalf of His Majesty, for, deckaring His Majesty's Royal. Assent to several Acts agreed upon by both Houses, do desire, the immediate attendance of the Hanguerable House in the House of Peers to hear the Commission rand, and the Commons being come thither, the said Commission, empowering the Lord Arch-bishop of Canterbury, the Lord High Changellor of Great Britain, and screen other Lords, therein named, to declare and notify the Royal Assent to the said Acts, was read accordingly, and the Royal Assent given to
