Since en Exprefs fent by the Imp:rial Ccmmiffioner atsived here; and brougbe a Letter wrieten by the Popes Nuncio; and the faid Imperial Commifionet, to our Magiffrates, wherein they give them atil Account, That being very defirbus to prevent the ill rönfiquences which thefe reifunderflandings between their Prince and them may at laf have, they swere; notwithflanding the ill fuccefis they had hitherto Had, refolved to continue their Eidideavours', in order to an Accomblodation, and that for that purpofr, they had been in Conference with the Electors Miniters, and had with them agreed on foor Preliminary Articles; which in tafe this City tia confent to, they doubted not fo to order Matters, as that all other points in diffe, rence Chould be adjofted to mutrial fatisfaction : Whereupdn our Magifrates have had feveral Meecingsto entliderof che faid Articles; whichare; That this City fhall acknowledge bis Electoral Highnefs as their Soveretign Prínce, and fhall pray his Pardon for what chey have offended him $\operatorname{In}$. That all Holitities fhatl cear:. That all Prifoners Shall be relcafed; and that allithat's palt fhall be forgotten: Andit's faid that they will agree to them, and have actord dingly relolved to eeturn the-Exprefs with an Anfwer to the Impertalnommiffiondrs Lettecr.
Fryanforts $O$ itiob ini. On Wedneflay laf the Count de Rofenberg, the firft of the Imperial Plenisporentiaries for the Conferengesthat are to be held here, arrived at ridantit) athd we expeethis Excellency in this City in few days; as likewife the French Ambaliadorts, and the other Minifters that are to affift at the faid Conferences. Our Letters from Ratiotonne tell us, That the States Affembled there, have fince the taking of straubourgo, wholly applyed themedves for the ferling the Points that yet remaia undetermined, concerning the Raifing and the Maiptaining the Army, they fome cime fince refolved to keep on fout for the deferiee of the Empire; and that the Duke of solffen Ploent and Count waldeck were propofed to be Generals of the faid Army.
