thirty-first day of December one thousand eight hundred and fourteen, inclusive; and that the same be paid in the manner specified in His Majesty's several proclamations now in force for the encouragement of seamen and landmen to enter into His Majesty's Royal Navy, and for the discovering seamen who may conceal themselves, and for giving rewards for procuring the voluntary service of seamen and landmen; whereof all persons concerned are to take notice, and govern themselves accordingly.
