Genova, Jan. 28. From *Bavaria* we have an account, that the States of that Circle had agreed on the several Propositions they are to furnish for the making up the Quota that Circle is to contribute to the Army of the Empire, which according to the Regulation made in the Dyet of *Ratisbonne*, is 1968 Foot, and 800 Horse; but because they cannot so easily raise Horse in *Bavaria* as in other parts of the Empire, these States have offered to furnish only 50 Horse, and in lieu of the other 250, to raise 300 Foot.
