A DISPATCH, of which the following is an extract, has been this day received from Viscount Castlereagh, dated Paris, July 17, 1815.

SINCE closing my dispatches of this date, I have received the accompanying communication from this Government :

(Translation.)

" I have the honour to acquaint your Lordship,

that Napoleon Buonaparte, not being able to escape from the English cruisers, or from the guards kept upon the coasts, has taken the resolution of going on board the English ship Bellerophon, Captain Maitland.

" I have the honour to be, &c.
