HIS Royal Highness the Prince Regent having been pleased, in the name and on the behalf of His Majesty, to appoint General His Grace Charles Duke of Richmond, &c. K. G. to be Captain-General and Governor in Chief in and over the Provinces of Lower and Upper Canada, Nova Scotia, and New Brunswick, and the Islands of Prince Edward and Cape Breton, His Grace this day took the usual oaths as Governor of the said Provinces and Islands.
