wHEREAS by an Act, passed in the present , sussion of Parliament, intitulet: "An Act to $8 i$ regulate the irade between His. Majesty's posOr sessims in America and the West: Indies, and ${ }^{2}$. other places in Anerica and the West Indies, : it is enaceed, that if His Majesty shatlodeem it exo pedient to extend the provisions of the said Act to any port or ports not enumerated in the schedula marked A, anuexied to the said Act, it shall be lawful tor His Majesıy, bÿ Order in Conincil; to extend the provisions of the said Act to such pirt or ports; His Majesty is thereupon pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to order, that from and after the passing of this Order, all arrictes permitted by the said Act to be iphorted monard exported fron the ports enmmerated, in schedule $A$ amexed to the saill "Act, stall and nay be in like mamer imported into and exported from the port of Annotto Bay, in the island of Jamaica, on payment of the dinies, and subject to the gales, regnlations, penalties, and furfeitures enacted by the said Act: And the Right llonourable the Lorats Conmissioners of His Majesty's Treasury are to give the necessary directions herein accurdingly.

"And it is hereby furtiterord rad, hat all deeds, convevnnces, halisicis, wintell cmotracts, or other instumens in witma hercafter to be made and executed, whereby hiy lands, houres, buildiugs, or other immo rabe properly, situate withon the said Colony of Sainl Lucia. on wherely any slaves resident and bring withm the aid Cidony, ar whereby any right or murest in or to any such lands, houses, buildings, imboveab, e property, or slaves, shall be comveyea, ransterred, alienated, sold, mortgaged, charged, or in any wise whatsoever affected, or which shall in any maner relate to or concern any such laurs, tionses; buildings, immoverble property. or slaves, shall be acknowledged before the said Registrar, and by hine recorted at length in his Office; in haniner and form bereinatier mentioned."
"Aud it is hereby further ordered, that all such deeds; conveyances, translers, writen contracts, and other instrments as afiresaid, shall be acknowledged, in mamer hareinatier mentioned, before the said Registiar, at his Office, at the 「uwa of Castries storesaid, within one calcudar month from nud after the day on whiel the same may respectively bave been execured, in those cases in which all the parties ur the party exccuting the same, were or inas, at the tinie of the execution thereol, resident whthin the sajp Colony of Saint Lucia; and within six calefidar monta= frome and after the day on which che same may roppectively have been exconted, in thone ches in which allor any of the parties exccuting lie same were or was; as the the of his, her, on their excenting the same, residen within any oiher of His Majory's Colonies in the West Inties or in Srenth America ; and within Welve calendar hionthis from and atier the day on which the same may respectively have been executed, in those cases in which all or any of the parics excenting the same wereor was, at the tine of the execuition thereot, resilent in any other comatry or plice"
"And it i, hereby further ordered, that the said Registrar shall pot recurd or acetpt for registration, any such deed, conveynace, transict, writen comtract, or ohher instrument as ateresai!!, unless all and every the persons execuing the same: shall, by themsties, or by their arturncy or attomies lawfinly authorised in that bellal, in mamer hereinafter mentioned, appear betore hins the shid Registrar, und achnowledge such deed, conveyance, transfer, written connacr, or ohber instrment, as and for his, her, or their net sum dead."
