India Board, May 27, 1826.

A DISPATCH has been received at the East India-House from the Governor in Council at Bombay, dated the 4th February 1826; of which the following is an extract:

WE take advantage of the sailing of the *Lonach*, free trader, to inform your Honourable Court, that we have received a letter from Sir Charles Metcalfe, Bart. conveying the very satisfactory intelligence of the storm and capture of the town of *Bhurtpore*, on the morning of the 18th January, and that the citadel had surrendered at discretion the same evening. The letter also mentions that *Doorjun Saul*, the usurper, and his son, had been intercepted in an attempt to escape, and were prisoners in the British camp.
