RDERS for the Court's going into mourning, on Thursday next the 11th instant, for His late Royal Highness Frederick Duke of York and Albany, His Majesty's next Brother, viz.

The Ladies to wear black bombazines, plain muslins or long lawn linen, crape hoods, shamoy shoes and gloves, and crape fans.

Undress-Dark Norwich crape.

The Gentlemen to wear black cloth, without buttons on the sleeves or pockets, plain muslin or long lawn cravats and weepers, shamoy shoes and gloves, crape hatbands, and black swords and buckles.

Undress-Dark grey frocks.

The Earl Marshal's Order for a General Mourning for His late Royal Highness the Duke of York and of Albany.

In pursuance of His Majesty's commands; these are to give public notice, that upon the present

melancholy occasion, of the death of His late Royal Highness Frederick Duke of York and of Albany, next Brother to His Majesty, it is expected that all persons do put themselves into deep mourning; the said mourning to begin on Thursday next the 11th instant.

#### GENERAL ORDER.

Horse-Guards, January 8, 1827.

Orders for Mourning for the Army for Field-Marshal His late Royal Highness the Duke of York and Albany, Commander in Chief of His Majesty's Forces.

The King does not require that the Officers of the Army should wear any other mourning with their uniforms, on the present melancholy occasion than black crape over the ornamental part of the cap or hat, the sword knot, and on the left arm; with the following exceptions, viz.

Officers on duty are to wear black gloves, black, crape over the ornamental part of the cap or hat, the sword knot, and on the left arm; the sash covered:

with black crape; black gorget fibband; and a black crape scarf over the right shoulder.

When Officers appear at Court in their uniforms, they are to wear black crape over the ornamental part of the cap or hat, the sword knot, and on the left arm; a black crape scarf over the right shoulder; black waistcoat, breeches, stockings, and buckles.

The drums of regiments are to be covered with black; and black crape is to be hung from the pike of the colour-staff of infantry, and from the standardstaff and trumpets of cavalry.
