WE cannot but with Hearts filled with unexpressible Exultation, bless the wonderful goodness of Almighty God, in the timely preventing, and by unusual ways discovering the most Traiterous and Bloody Conspiracy of Multitudes of Your Majesties Subjects, of Fanatical, Atheistical and Antimonarchick principles of all sorts, degrees and qualities, inhumanely and barbarously to murder Your Royal Majesty, and Your Dearest Brother, (His Highness James Duke of York) and in consequence thereof to bring the best of Governments both in Church and State, by Law established in this Nation, into Anarchy, and apparent confusion, had it not been by even Miraculous ways prevented and discovered.

WE Your Majesty's most Dutiful and Loyal Subjects having understood to our great Amazement, the hor-

rid and Execrable Conspiracy formed and carried on by Persons of dangerous Principles, and attached to the Government, for the Abdication of Your Majesty's Sacred Person, and of his Royal Highness Your only Brother, and for the involving this Your Majesty's Kingdom in immediate Blood and Confusion, in order to the total Subversion of the Monarchy, under which we and our Ancestors have continued for many Ages, a most happy and prosperous People, to the envy of all neighbouring Nations.

We think it our Duty with all humility to adore the Providence of Almighty God for the repeated Wonders of his Care over Your Majesty, and more particularly for the happy discovery of this horrid Conspiracy, as a mercy towards Your People, not inferior to those never to be forgotten, of Your Majesty's escape from Worcester, and that of Your Miraculous Restauration, beseeching God ever more to continue the same gracious care over Your Sacred Person and Government.

Vienna, June 27. The Letters from Hungary say, That the Vizier of Buda is encamped with a Body of 25000 Men near Gran, with which he intends to pass the Danube, and afterwards to make an Incursion into *Messia* and *Moravia*. To prevent which, the Duke of Lorraine has detached a considerable number of Men as well to reinforce General *Schutz*, as to enable him to defend the Passages on the River *Waag*. The duties of Count *Teckley* who reside here declared, That the 20th of the next Month their Masters Troops will renew the Acts of Hostility, which were suspended by the late Truce concluded between the Emperor and the Count. The Emperor has constituted Monsieur *Stratzman* to be his Chancellour, in the place of Baron *Hocker*, lately deceased.

Vienna July 1. On Monday last the Sieur *Stratzman* took the accustomed Oath of Chancellour to the Emperor, and since his Imperial Majesty has been pleased to confer upon him the Dignity of a Baron of the Empire. The Duke of *Saxen-Lawenbourg* is returned to the Army with further Instructions to the Duke of Lorraine, how he shall govern himself in the present Juncture of Affairs. Several Expresses have of late been sent to the King of Poland, who is arrived at *Cracow*; according to our advices from thence, His Majesty, as is said, will march in Person with 20000 Men, to re-inforce the Emperor's Army in Hungary. The Duke of *Lorraine* having perfected the Fortifications of *Raab*, and re-inforced the Garrison, with a considerable Body of Men, is posted with the greatest part of the Imperial Army near unto it. In the mean time the Grand *Vizier* is advanced to *St. Weissenberg*, within two hours of the Imperial Camp, with 50000 Foot, and 30000 Horse. Count *Teckley* continues with the Grand *Vizier*. The Emperor has sent Orders to Count *Chackey*, to destroy the Fortifications of *Nitria*, and to withdraw from thence the Artillery that was sent thither for the Defence of the Place. We have fresh advice that the Turks are encamped in the Mountains called *Schiltberg*, and that the Duke of *Lorraine* continues posted with the Emperor's Forces in the Neighbourhood of *Raab*.

Ravibone, July 8. On Sunday last the Imperial Commissioner, the Bishop of *Aichstadt*, delivered a Memorial to the Dyet on the part of the Emperor, in which, after a Deduction of what had been transacted at the late Assembly at *Franckfort*, and the hinderance put to the further Progress of the Treaty, by reason of the differences between the two Colleges here, several overtures are added to be made to France, viz. 1. That that Crown restore all places that they have taken contrary to the Treaty of *Münster*, and ascertain the Damages sustained by
