A PROCLAMATION.

GEORGE, R.

HEREAS Our Parliament stands prorogued to Thursday the twentieth day of this instant . December; We, with the advice of our Privy Council, do hereby publish and declare, that the said Parliament shall be further prorogued, on the said twentieth day of this instant December, to Tuesday the twenty-second day of January next; and We have given order to Our Chancellor of that part of Our United Kingdom called Great Britain, to prepare a commission for proroguing the same accordingly; and We do further hereby, with the advice afore-said, declare Our Royal Will and Pleasure, that the said Parliament shall, on the said twenty-second day of January next, assemble and be held for the dispatch of divers urgent and important affairs: And the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and the Knights, Citizens, and Burgesses, and the Commissioners for Shires and Boroughs of the House of Commons, ore hereby required and commanded to give their attendance accordingly, at Westminster, on the said swenty-second day of January next.

Given at Our Court at St. James's, this thirteenth day of December one thousand eight hundred and twenty-seven, and in the eighth year of Our reign.
