his Lordship took his place at the Board accordingly.

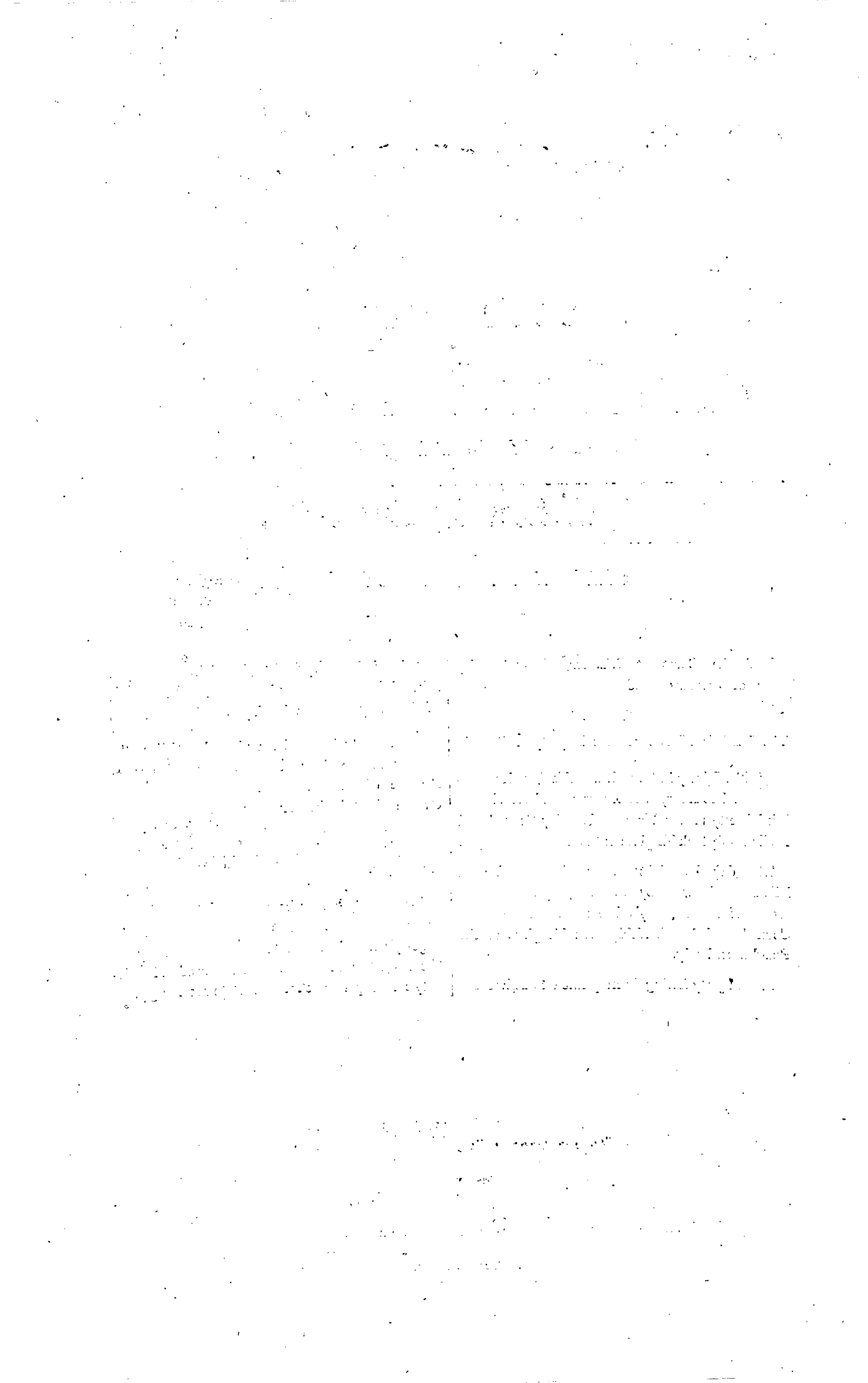
This day the Right Honourable Edward Lord
