At the Court at St. James's, May 13, 1829.

THE King, as Sovereign of the Most Noble Order of the Garter, has been graciously pleased, by letters patent under his royal sign manual and the great seal of the Order, bearing date this day, to dispense with all the statutes and regulations usually observed in regard to installation, and to give and grant unto the Most Noble Charles Duke of Richmond, Knight Elect of the said Order, and duly invested with the ensigns thereof, full power and authority to exercise all rights and privileges belonging to a Knight Companion of the Most Noble Order of the Garter, in as full and ample a manner as if His Grace had been formally installed, any decree, rule, or usage to the contrary notwithstanding.
