AT the Court at *Windsor*, the 22d day of *June* 1829,

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

IT is this day ordered by His Majesty in Council, that the Parliament be prorogued, from Wednesday the twenty-fourth day of this instant June, to Thursday the twentieth day of August next.

At the Court at Windsor, June 22, 1829.

The King, as Sovereign of the Most Noble Order of the Garter, has been graciously pleased, by letters patent under His royal sign manual and the great seal of the Order, to dispense with all the statutes and regulations usually observed in regard to installation, and to give and grant unto the Right Honourable George Earl of Ashburnham, Knight Elect of the said Order, and duly invested with the ensigns thereof, full power and authority to exercise all rights and privileges belonging to a Knight Companion of the Most Noble Order of the Garter, in as full and ample a manner as if his Lordship had been formally installed, any decree, rule, or usage to the contrary notwithstanding.
