ELECTION OF A TEMPORAL PEER OF IRELAND.

In pursuance of an Act, passed in the fortieth year of the reign of His Majesty King George the Third, intituled "An Act to regulate the mode by which the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and the Commons, to serve in the Parliament of the United Kingdom, on the part of Ireland, shall be summoned and returned to the said Parliament," I do hereby give notice, that writs, bearing date this day, have issued for electing a Temporal Peer of Ireland, to succeed to the vacancy made by the demise of Francis Earl of Bandon, in the House of Lords of the said United Kingdom; which said writs are severally directed to the following Peers, being the Peers who sat and voted in the House of Lords in Ireland before the Union, and whose right to vote on the election of Temporal Peers of Ireland hath, upon claims made on their behalf, been admitted since the Union by the House of Lords of the said United Kingdom; and that the said writs are ready to be delivered at this Office:
