 Fut the Garifons of Namur，Charleroy，and Mons，do not fiucseed fo well，the Peafants int all the French villages on that fide being in Arms，and baving killed and wounded fer veral Spanith Troopers that came to raile Contributions．Our German Lertes，tell ns，that the King of Poland and the Duk $\mathrm{c}_{\text {of }}$ Lorrain uill nar fuffer the Garifon of Newhicufe！to recire ，but have refoived to keep that place very clofely blocked up rbis winter，being well affited that the Tarks that are in ir，will be forced to fubmit before Spring upon any terms：And as for Count Teckeley，they will not treat with himp，till he firlt pofitively declares for the E．nperor， and turns his Arms agdunft the Turks，and have limired Him at time for the doing it：That the Croats wiith fome Polifh Troops，have made Incurfions as tar as Ponf Eflecke，and have taken 3 or 4 Calles near Buda；and that the King of Poland and the Duke of Lorrain intended to artack Buda and Peft，if the Seafon will permir，or otherwife to．Block therm up．That Caminiec will be lihewile blocked up this Wintor by the Roles；and that the Emperor and the King of Poland， are fending Ambafladors to the Cars of Mofcovy，to engage them to make War upon the Turks in the Spring．
