A PROCLAMATION.

WILLIAM, R.

HEREAS Our Parliament stands prorogued to Tuesday the twenty-second day of this instant November; We, with the advice of Our Privy Council, do hereby publish and declare, that the said Parliament shall be further prorogued, on the said twenty-second day of this instant November, to Tuesday the sixth day of December next; and We have given order to Our Chancellor of that part of Our United Kingdom called Great Britain, to prepare a commission for proroguing the same accordingly; and We do further hereby, with the advice afore-

said, declare Our Royal Will and Pleasure, that the said Parliament shall, on the said sixth day of December next, assemble and be held for the dispatch of divers urgent and important affairs: And the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and the Knights, Citizens, and Burgesses, and the Commissioners for Shires and Burghs of the House of Commons, are hereby required and commanded to give their attendance accordingly, at Westminster, on the said sixth day of December next.

Given at Our Court at St. James's, this twentyfirst day of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, and in the second year of Our reign.
