IT is this day ordered by His Majesty in Council, that his Grace the Archbishop of Canterbury do prepare a form of prayer and thanksgiving to Almighty God, for His mercy in having removed from us that grievous disease with which several places in this kingdom have been lately visited; and that such form of prayer and thanksgiving be used in all churches and chapels in England and Wales, and in the town of Berwick-upon-Tweed, upon Sunday the fourteenth day of April next; which day His Majesty is hereby pleased to appoint to be observed as a day of general thanksgiving:

And it is hereby further ordered, that His Ma-

jesty's Printer do forthwith print a competent number of copies of the said form of prayer and thanksgiving, that the same may be forthwith sent round and read in the several churches of England and Wales, and of the town of Berwick-upon-Tweed.
