**I** T is this day ordered by His Majesty in Council, that the Parliament, which stands prorogued to Thursday the twenty-fifth day of September instant, be further prorogued to Thursday the twenty-third day of October next.

WHEREAS by an Act, passed in the third and fourth year of His Majesty's reign, intituled "An Act for the genetal regulation of the Customs," it is, amongst other things, enacted, that goods of places within the limits of the East India Company's charter shall be imported into such ports of the United Kingdom as shall be approved of by the Lords of the Treasury, and declared by an Order in Council, to be fit and proper for such importation; and whereas the port of Newcastle-on-Tyne has been approved of by the Lords of His Majesty's Treasury for that purpose; His Majesty, by and with the advice of His Majesty's Privy Council, is thereupon pleased to declare, and it is hereby de-

clared, that the port of Newcastle-on-Tyne is a port fit and proper for the importation of goods from places within the limits of the East India Company's charter:

And the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury are to give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
