Right Honourable Henry John Viscount Palmer-  
ston; the Right Honourable John Russell (com-  
monly called Lord John Russell); and the Right  
Honourable Charles Grant; to be three of His  
Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, they were  
this day, by His Majesty's command, sworn three of  
His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State accord-  
ingly.

His Majesty in Council was this day pleased to  
appoint the Right Honourable Charles Poulett  
Thomson President of the Committee of Council  
appointed for the consideration of all matters relating  
to Trade and Foreign Plantations.
