purporting to have been made by the said Insolvent, under circumstances which will be mentioned at the said meeting, and bringing such Mortgagees to account for the respective sums of money received by them from the tenants of the said Insolvent's estate in respect thereof; or otherwise to assent to or dissent from the said Assignees compounding, submitting to arbitration, or otherwise agreeing the same, or any dispute, matter or thing respectively relating thereunto; and on other special affairs.
