### TWO-PENNY POST RIDING WORK ...

SEALED tenders will be received by the Postmaster-General to perform this service, on or before the 1st of December next, to be superscribed "Tenders for Two-penny Post Rides." The conpract to commence on and from the 6th April 1836. "The riders to be of good character, and liable to

discharge on the requisition of the Postmaster-General. The horses to be kept in good condition, to the good liking of the Postmaster-General, and subject to removal if not approved of by him.

The present distances, and the services performed by the riders, which will be strictly enforced, are stated at foot. The Postmaster-General to have the right to direct alteration or extension of the rides within the Two-penny Post Delivery, and from time to time to fix and alter the hours and routes of the services to be respectively performed. The contractor to be subject to all orders and regulations which from time to time may be made by the Postmaster-General.

The terms per mile to be stated in words at length, and to include the expence of providing and maintaining the horses, equipments, riders, payment of duties, and every other charge of every sort and description, save and except the uniform hats and coats of the riders, and the saddle bags and pouches. The payment to be made at the expiration of eachquarter.

The contractor to provide two responsible sureties (to be approved by the Postmaster-General), whoshall be bound with him, jointly and severally, in a bond to the Crown, in a sum of  $\pounds 1000$ , for the due performance of his contract, to be recoverable asliquidated damages in case of any breach or default.

Power to determine the contract within three years, on six months notice on either side.
