Office of the Lord Chamberlain to the Queen, Queen's House, St. James's, March 11, 1836.

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Queen will hold a Drawing-Room on Thursday, March 24.

It is absolutely necessary that all Ladies intending to be presented, should send their names, with that of the Lady presenting them, to the Office of the Lord Chamberlain to the Queen, on or before Tuesday 22d of March, in order that they may be submitted to Her Majesty.

All Ladies and Gentlemen attending the Drawing-Room are requested to bring three cards; one to be left in the Anti-room, another to be given to the Lord in Waiting to the King, and the third to the Lord Chamberlain to the Queen, who will announce the name to Her Majesty.

No Lady can present another, unless she herself attends the Drawing-Room.
