**T**HE King has been pleased to grant unto Sir John-Nicoll-Robert Campbell, Knt. His royal licence and permission that he may accept and wear the insignia of the Order of the Lion and Sun, of the first class, which His Majesty the Shah of Persia hath been pleased to confer upon him, in approbation of his conduct and services whilst attached to the Persian army:

And to command, that this His Majesty's concession and especial mark of His royal favour, together with the relative documents, be recorded in the College of Arms.

The King has been pleased to grant unto Sir Henry Pynn, Knt. Companion of the Most Honourable Military Order of the Bath, a Lieutenant-Colonel in the Army, and late Brigadier-General in the Portuguese Service, His royal licence and permission that he may accept and wear the insignia of the cross, of the third class, of the Order of Saint Ferdinand, and the supernumerary cross of the Order of Charles the Third, which the Queen Regent of Spain hath been pleased to confer upon him, in testimony of Her Majesty's approbation of his services during the Peninsular war:

And to command, that this His Majesty's concession and especial mark of His royal favour, together with the relative documents, be recorded in the College of Arms.
