DISPATCHES were received at Windsor-Castle, last night, announcing the death of Her Serene Highness the Duchess Dowager of Saxe Meinengen, Mother of Her Majesty, the Queen.

The melancholy event occurred on Sunday the 30th of April.

The Court will go into Mourning on Thursday next.
